The 1st Cavalry Division Assoc. headquarters will be at the Sheraton in downtown Billings.

We have 30 rooms blocked at a rate of \$47 for a single and \$55 for a double plus 4% accommodation tax. We have our hospitality suite reserved, the Explorer Room. The room has a casual seating of 100 people, has a bar set up and bathrooms convenient. If we fill 20 rooms we will only pay half price for the suite. When calling in your reservations please tell them LRRP/RANGER of the 1st Cavalry Div. Assoc. to give us the credit.

The Ramada Inn has a swimming pool with a water slide, an outdoor court that they will set up volleyball or badminton if we request, a Game room, a restaurant and a Lounge with live entertainment nightly. They are near the airport, 2 minutes from the largest Mall in Montana and has a convention center where rodeo's and other events are held.

We have choosen the Ramada Inn for the hospitality suite, which we wanted larger to comfortably accomadate our group and all the extras they have to keep the children occupied. The rates are in the same range as the hotels the 1st Cavalry has lined up. There will not be bus service to the Sheraton and we are not close enough to walk.

We need a few volunteers to arrive Aug. 4 and to be prepared to open the suite each day and close whenever, to obtain the beverages and paper supplies, keep us supplied in ice and keep the place in order. Please contact Bonnie if willing to help.

The 1st Cav. Div. Assoc., Col.(Ret.) Robert Litle and B.G. (Ret.) Art Junot, are working to finalize reunion activities, but two events that seem firm are a day at the horse race track and a Wagon Train for three days following General George Custer's trail on horse back. It will be prior to the reunion and the price will be approx. \$100 which will include the horse and provisions. This would be a great trip for the children and who knows how long there will be wilderness to enjoy.
