#### Nomination for The Ranger Hall of Fame

Step 1: Nominations were requested by email Step 1A: Time permitting nominations are being requested by newsletter (as I have said, we do not have all the info at this time so we are not moving very fast.) Step 2: Nominations will be compiled by the chapter Secretary. (a) Names of nominated persons and number of votes. (b) Names of nominators will be recorded, © Voters for a given name will become the write-up committee for that given name. Step 3: Board receives the list of nominaes with totals of votes - not the names of supporters.

Step 4: Board reviews nominations and refers the top 3, or

Unless otherwise by vote, a chosen group of 3 should be referred back to the Secretary.

Step 5: Secretary notifies the write-up committee for each accepted name. Secretary will notify the nominators of the rest of the list that they can submit again next year. Samples will be provided and deadline will be given.

Step 6: The 3 write-up committees will forward their finished articles to the Secretary. Secretary will forward them to the Reviewer for recommendation of the best one. (At this time, we are not sure who the Reviewer has to be.)

Step 7: Final selection will be forwarded to the chapter representative for the 75th RRA.

I do not know how well all this effort will go. This will be our first time submitting as a chapter effort. So please have patience.

A hot issue I will be working on this year with the 1st Cavalry Association is chapter membership. We, like other chapters, have not kept records on whom has filed an application for membership with the 1st Cavalry Division Association. The Cavalry Association is reviewing our known addresses.
